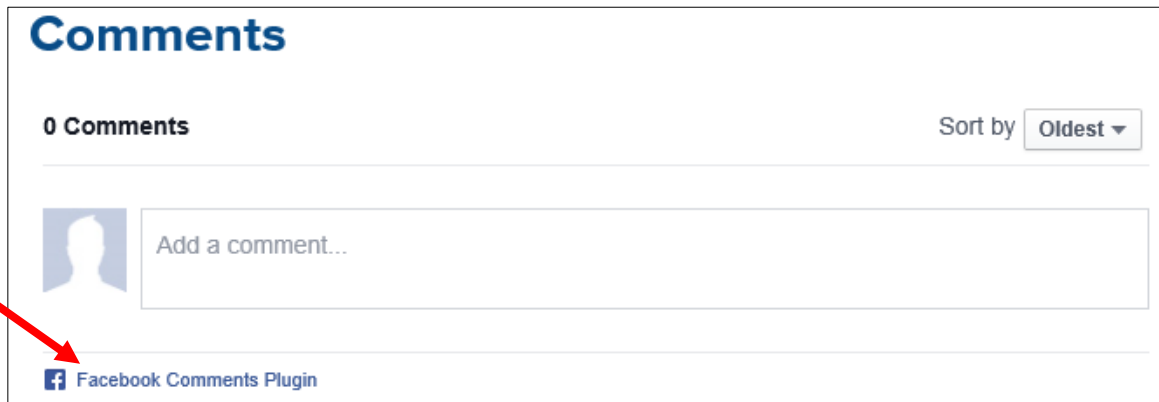


The Facebook Comments Plug-In on the walk website provides a great way to support your team and raise funds on social media. Here's how it works!

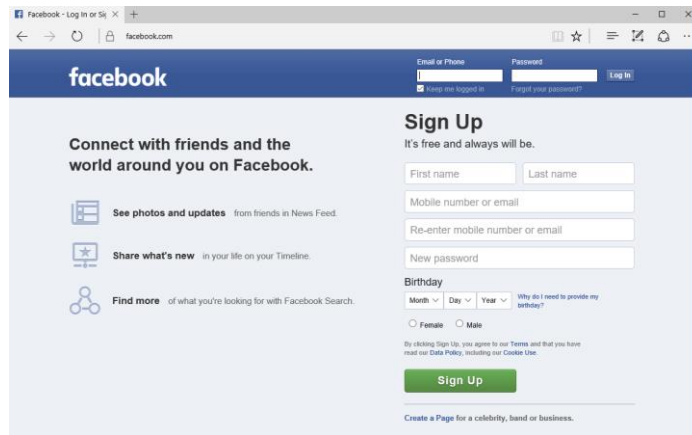
What is the Comments Plugin?

The Facebook Comments Plugin can be found at the bottom of your walk website home page, the bottom of every team page and the bottom of every walker web page. The Plugin allows people to comment on your site using their Facebook accounts. They can share this activity on their Facebook page as well.



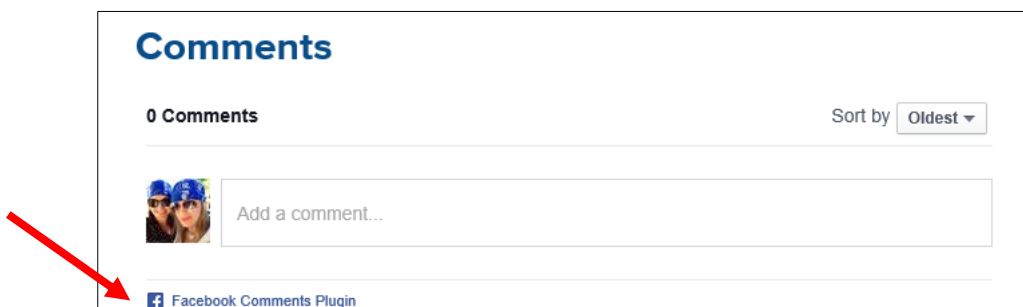
Step 1:

First, sign into your Facebook account.




Step 2:

Now go to the NAMI Walks page you wish to support. Find the Plugin at the bottom of the page.



Step 3:


Type in your message of support and encouragement.

Step 4:
